

# External Learner Immunization Requirements For MercyOne North Iowa Medical Center and Clinics and MercyOne New Hampton Medical Center & Clinic

Documentation of the below must be provided <u>prior</u> to beginning the learning experience:

# • <u>Tuberculin Skin Test</u>

- o Cannot be done more than one year prior to learning experience.
- Students with a past positive TB skin test must complete the TB Assessment Form and complete a chest x-ray if indicated.

## Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)

 Written documentation of two (2) doses of Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccines or serologic (blood test) evidence of immunity.

### Hepatitis B

Hep B vaccine series (or signed refusal) prior to their experience.

## • Chicken Pox:

- Evidence of immunity of Varicella-Zoster (Chickenpox). Evidence of immunity includes any of the following:
  - Written documentation of vaccination with 2 doses of varicella vaccine,
  - Laboratory evidence of immunity or laboratory confirmation of disease,
  - Diagnosis or verification of a history of varicella disease by a health-care provider, or
  - Diagnosis or verification of a history of Herpes Zoster (shingles) by a health-care provider.

#### Covid19 Vaccination:

 Written documentation of completed COVID19 Vaccination per Mercy's requirements or signed declination.

## • Tdap vaccination

 This vaccination is <u>not required</u>, however highly recommended for those with the potential to interact with children.

## • Influenza vaccination (for those that will be rotating between October 1st and March 31st)

MercyOne North Iowa & MercyOne New Hampton does understand that some will not be able to receive the influenza vaccination based on medical reasons or religious beliefs. If this is the case, you will need to fill out MercyOne's <u>Application for Influenza Vaccination</u> <u>Exemption</u> form along with supporting documentation from either a physician or religious leader.
